

Marine Creatures sighted, stranded or landed In Cornwall during 2007

- 1/1/07 A pod of 7 dolphins was seen heading eastward off Carn Barges SW447233 into Mounts Bay at 1510 hrs
- 1/1/07 A dead oiled Guillemot, a 20 cm Grey Triggerfish, with eyes still present and 15 Goose Barnacles attached to a piece of wood were found on the strandline at Porthmeor Beach SW516410
- 2/1/07 A dead Guillemot and a fresh blue jellyfish were found on the strandline at Porthmeor Beach SW516410
- 2/1/07 A pod of about 8 Bottlenose Dolphins, including a juvenile, was seen playing and breaching at Little London SW525302 near St. Michael's Mount Mounts Bay.
- 2/1/07 3 dead Triggerfish, a Nightlight Jellyfish, *Pelagia noctiluca* and 15 *Janthina janthina* Violet Sea-snails were found on the strandline at Gwithian SW579411
- 2/1/07 A pod of 12 Bottlenose Dolphins was seen off Marazion SW515301
- 3/1/07 A pod of 7 or more Bottlenose Dolphins was watched hunting and feeding with some breaching for 40 minutes off The Greeb SW5229
- 4/1/07 3 *Janthina janthina* and one *J.pallida* Violet Sea-snails and cuttlefish bones of *Sepia officinalis*, *S.elegans* and *S.orbigniana* were found on the strandline at Perranporth SW756544, and in a cast up specimen of the Common Mussel *Mytilus edulis* a Pea Crab *Pinnotheres pinnotheres*.
- 4/1/07 2 Grey Triggerfish, 39 cm and 25 cm long, and 10 Goose barnacles attached to a piece of wood, were found on the strandline at Mawgan Porth SW8467
- 6/1/07 A very small Kemp's Ridley Turtle was found stranded alive on the high tide line at Woolacombe Beach SS450420 North Devon. Two BDMLR medics were surfing there at the time and their attention was drawn to the stranded turtle. They arranged to meet a representative of West Hatch RSPCA wildlife hospital who had agreed to give it temporary accommodation and treatment. A couple of days later it was transferred to the Weymouth Sea Life Centre's Turtle rehabilitation Centre where they have more experience with turtles and facilities to deal with it. The centre was very surprised to receive such a small turtle, which was only about 35cm long. The female turtle was very hypothermic on arrival, with a bleak outlook, but after raising its temperature and initiating feeding, it began to recover well. The staff are now hopeful of releasing it back into the wild off The Canaries in late April.
- 7/1/07 2 Harbour Porpoises were feeding beneath Gannets off Porthgwarra SW371216 at 1200 hrs, and one Harbour Porpoise was seen off The Minack Theatre SW387200 at 1300 hrs
- 8/1/07 A Triggerfish was found stranded on the beach at Gywnver SW362276

- 8/1/07 7 Harbour Porpoises were sighted off Berry Head SX948567 at 1000 hrs.
- 8/1/07 A Nickar Nut, *Caesalpinia bondoc*, was found on the strandline at Fistril Beach SW797620
- 9/1/07 3 Harbour Porpoises were feeding in very rough seas, 600 metres south of Porthgwarra SW371216, with hundreds of Auks and Kittiwakes, from 1300 to 1330 hrs
- 10/1/07 A 25 cm dead Triggerfish was found stranded at the western end of Widemouth Bay SS1901
- 13/1/07 8 to 10 Harbour Porpoises were watched feeding in rough seas for 10 minutes, 100 yards off Porthcothan Bay SW8572 with Herring Gulls overhead
- 14/1/07 A Sea Purse tropical Bean, *Dioclea reflexa*, 3 dead Triggerfish, 3 Violet Sea Snails and 3 groups of Goose Barnacles, one attached to a piece of plastic the others to pieces of wood, were found on the strandline at Sennen SW3526
- 19/1/07 6 dolphins, probably Bottlenose Dolphins, were seen heading east from St. Ives NCI Lookout SW521411 at 0945 hrs.
- 20/1/07 3 Fin Whales were feeding with hundreds of seabirds off Porthgwarra SW371216 from 1430 to 1530 hrs. One surfaced 250metres from shore, and 3 were seen to spout at the same time. They moved out and away to the west.
- 21/1/07 3 Fin Whales were seen off Porthgwarra SW371216 during the morning, They were well offshore. Whale spouts were seen off Land's End SW342253, inside the Longships Lighthouse, as they headed north at 1600 hrs
- 21/1/07 About 500 Goose Barnacles were found attached to a large piece of stranded driftwood at Watergate Bay SW8464. They looked fresh and newly stranded with 45mm shells and 75mm peduncles.
- 21/1/07 A Stranded large plastic buoy with about 100 Goose Barnacles attached was found on the tide line at Sennen SW3626. Among the barnacles were 4 Columbus Crabs, *Planes minutus*, but one was dead. The other three were collected and taken to The Blue Reef Aquarium at Newquay
- 21/1/07 A 5 metre male Pilot whale carcass was washed up on Saunton Sands SS4335
- 22/1/07 A Columbus Crab was found among Goose Barnacles stranded on a large log at Watergate Bay SW8464. It was taken alive to Plymouth University where it seems to be doing quite well.
- 27/1/07 There was a sighting of what was believed to be a Harbour Porpoise, approximately 75 metres off Haldon Pier, Torquay SX916631. It appeared to be feeding
- 28/1/07 A Bottlenose Dolphin was seen following a Canoeist and generally milling about at Broadsands Tor Bay SX895575 at 1130 hrs
- 29/1/07 2 Harbour Porpoises were seen ¼ mile south of Logan Rock SW396219 at 0930 hrs
- 29/1/07 3 Harbour Porpoises, including one juvenile, were feeding with seabirds 600 metres offshore at Porthgwarra SW371216 at 1130 hrs.
- 30/1/07 6 Harbour Porpoises were feeding with seabirds 600 metres offshore at Porthgwarra SW371216 at 1000 hrs

- 31/1/07 6 Harbour Porpoises, including 2 juveniles, were feeding with seabirds 600 metres south of Porthgwarra SW371216 at 1030 hrs
- 31/1/07 A dolphin was seen off Sennen SW3526 at mid-day.
- 1/2/07 A 10" diameter *Rhizostoma octopus* jellyfish was found stranded on the high tide line at Perranporth SW756544
- 1/2/07 About 100 Harbour Porpoises were watched from 1045 to 1400 hrs off the mouth of the River Camel SW9277
- 2/2/07 A dolphin was seen off Pendennis Point SW826314 during the afternoon
- 2/2/07 A Harbour Porpoise was seen off Constantine Bay SW8574 at 1200 hrs
- 4/2/07 A pod of 6 to 10 Harbour Porpoises with some juveniles, were feeding off Kellan Head, Port Quin SW969812 at 1300 hrs They were actively feeding, chasing fish. Further out to sea, lots of gannets were feeding in a bait-ball fashion, indicating the presence of lots of fish.
- 4/2/07 2 or 3 Harbour Porpoises were off St. Anthony Head SW846311, 200 metres toward Black Rock. They did not appear to be feeding and did not stay in the area for long. A yacht in the area stopped and did not harass the animals
- 4/2/07 A pod of 8 Bottlenose Dolphins including a juvenile, was seen just outside Penzance Harbour SW476303 at 1430 hrs. They seem to be very attracted to moving boats. When the boat stopped, they moved away, but as soon as the boat started to move again they surrounded it.
- 4/2/07 7 Common Dolphins and a baby, were in Mounts Bay in position 50°6.80N 5°31.06W at 1455 hrs
- 5/2/07 Six dolphins were seen passing the headland from the NCI Lookout at Rame Head SX422488 at 1030 hrs
- 5/2/07 2 Harbour Porpoises, including a juvenile, were seen heading north just west of the Brisons SW340311 at 1030 hrs, and at least 6 Harbour Porpoises, including a juvenile, were feeding with seabirds 600 metres to 1 Km south of Porthgwarra Cove SW371216 at 1230 hrs
- 7/2/07 2 Harbour Porpoise were 300 metres west of Sennen Harbour SW350263 and two more were 400 metres north of the harbour from 1230 to 1330 hrs
- 14/2/07 At least 6 Bottlenose Dolphins, including one juvenile, came into St. Ives Bay SW5241 from the north from 1230 to 1300 hrs.
- 14/2/06 A pod of 8 to 11 Bottlenose Dolphins, including 2 juveniles, headed eastward into St. Ives Bay SW5241, at 1515 hrs, breaching and playing as they went and then stopped, and appeared to be feeding for a while in an area off the Holiday Park. At 1545 hrs they resumed playing, but some of the play seemed to be quite aggressive toward the two young ones, looking like a severe telling off, by the adults.
- 18/2/07 2 Harbour Porpoises were seen heading slowly east 100 yards off Capstone Point SS519418 at 1412 hrs
- 18/2/07 A Harbour Porpoise was seen off The Cowloe, Sennen SW349266 at 1450 hrs and a Grey Seal was seen bottling 500 metres off The Old Success Inn Sennen SW354265 at 1600 hrs.
- 18/2/07 An Ocean Sunfish was spotted 3 times just below the NCI Lookout at Cape Cornwall SW349318 at 1530 hrs

- 19/2/07 3 Harbour Porpoises, including one juvenile, were 700 metres off Lizard Point SW694115 from 1230 to 1330 hrs.
- 20/2/07 6 Bottlenose Dolphins, including one juvenile, were just west of St. Michael's Mount SW515301 from 0930 to 1000 hrs, and 2 Harbour Porpoises were west of the Brisons SW340311 at 1230 hrs
- 21/2/07 A Harbour Porpoise was about 1 Km northeast of St. Ives Island SW521411 at 1530 hrs
- 21/2/07 A Grey Seal was seen feeding on a large fish at the surface, below the NCI Lookout at Cape Cornwall SW349318
- 25/2/07 A Harbour Porpoise was beneath feeding seabirds 1 Km south of Porthgwarra Cove SW371216 early in the afternoon
- 1/3/07 2 dolphins, possibly Common Dolphins, were seen close inshore at Porthminster Beach SW521401 at 1400 hrs. They were watched until they headed safely out to sea
- 6/3/07 A pod of Bottlenose Dolphins were seen playing off the rock at Gwithian SW579411 at 1530 hrs
- 7/3/07 A Grey Seal was seen at the surface below the NCI Lookout at Cape Cornwall SW349318 at 1020 hrs
- 8/3/07 A Harbour Porpoise was seen 500 metres south of Porthgwarra Cove SW371216 at 0930 hrs
- 10/3/07 2 Harbour Porpoises were seen 400 metres south east of Lizard Point SW694115 at 1300 hrs
- 12/3/07 8 Bottlenose Dolphins headed east off St Ives SW521411 at 1500 hrs
- 12/3/07 A single unidentified dolphin was seen heading north about 50 metres off the NCI Lookout at Cape Cornwall SW349318 at 1310 hrs
- 12/3/07 A single dolphin was seen heading north off the NCI Lookout at Cape Cornwall SW349318 at 1310 hrs
- 13/3/07 8 Bottlenose Dolphins headed west off St Ives SW521411 at 1200 hrs
- 13/3/07 2 Harbour Porpoises were seen 50 metres north of Cape Cornwall SW349318 at 1300 hrs
- 14/3/07 At least 3 Harbour Porpoises including one juvenile were seen 400 metres south of Porthgwarra SW371216 at 0930 hrs
- 14/5/07 8 Bottlenose Dolphins were very active and bow riding off Hayle SW551382 from 1030 hrs onward, and later headed east.
- 15/3/07 About 100 Harbour Porpoises headed east off the NCI Lookout at St Ives SW521411 at 0730 hrs
- 15/3/07 15 Harbour Porpoises headed west off St Ives SW542411 at 1340 hrs
- 16/3/07 15 Harbour Porpoises were milling around for a while off St. Ives SW521411 at 1400 hrs before heading east when approached by a fishing boat..
- 17/3/07 10 Harbour Porpoises were seen feeding and heading east off St. Ives SW521411 at 1500 hrs
- 21/3/07 3 Harbour Porpoise were seen SSW of The Minack Cliff Theatre SW387220 at 1230 hrs. Two were about 500 metres off and the other 800 metres
- 21/3/07 2 Bottlenose Dolphin were seen in Mounts Bay in position 50°07N 06°31.5W at 1505 hrs. Slowly heading south
- 23/3/07 2 Harbour Porpoises were seen ¼ mile west of Land's End SW341253 at 1030 hrs

- 24/3/07 5 or 6 Bottlenose Dolphins, including young, arrived off Gyllyngvase Beach SW808316 at 1630 hrs, but were harassed by a jetskier who drove into and around the pod at speed numerous times. Ignoring many people on the beach who protested. Eventually he moved away and the pod quickly headed back east.
- 25/3/07 2 Bottlenose Dolphins were inside Fowey Estuary SX120510, bow riding boats up and down the river for 2 hours from 1500 hrs. One of the dolphins had a golf ball sized chunk out of the rear base of its dorsal fin
- 25/3/07 A pod of 8 Bottlenose Dolphin was seen heading east off Portreath SW653454 with some surface activity, at 1000 hrs
- 28/3/07 A pod of Bottlenose Dolphins was seen very close in at Falmouth Harbour SW823333
- 30/3/07 6 Harbour Porpoises, including 2 juveniles, were south of Porthgwarra SW371216 from 0800 to 1000hrs
- 30/3/07 An Ocean Sunfish was close inshore at Porth SW830629, at midday
- 1/4/07 A Grey Seal was seen at the surface, below the NCI Lookout at Cape Cornwall SW349318 at 1221 hrs
- 1/4/07 A Harbour Porpoise was seen just west of the Runnelstone SW369220 at 0930 hrs
- 3/4/07 3 or 4 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen just off the Minack Cliff Theatre SW387220 in the early evening
- 4/4/07 2 Bottlenose Dolphin and a juvenile have been seen in the Penzance Harbour area over the past 10 days, but the juvenile has not been seen on the most recent sightings
- 4/4/07 5 Bottlenose Dolphins were spotted off the south Devon coast between Stoke Point SX560458 and Wembury Cottage SX541466
- 5/4/07 4 Harbour Porpoises were seen feeding ¼ mile south of the Longships Lighthouse SW320253 at 1430 hrs
- 5/4/07 A pod of about 10 large dolphins, probably Bottlenose, was seen heading east in Bigbury Bay SX6642 at 1130 hrs
- 6/4/07 During a watch off Capstone Point SS519418 a Harbour Porpoise was seen heading slowly east, 300 metres off, from 1014 to 1224 hrs and a Grey Seal was bottling 500 metres to the west. At 1100 hrs 3 Harbour Porpoises were seen resting and milling with some surface activity, but no breaching, whilst drifting west 300 metres off, and later at 1800 hrs a Grey Seal was seen bottling for about 1 minute 100 metres west of the Point.
- 6/4/07 2 dolphins, probably Bottlenose Dolphins, were seen bow riding a boat off Fowey Harbour entrance SX120509
- 6/4/07 A Fin Whale was seen off Nare Head SW916370
- 7/4/07 20 dolphins, in three groups were seen heading east in St. Austell Bay SX0449 during the day
- 7/4/07 2 Bottlenose Dolphins were in the mouth of Penzance Harbour SW476303, between the piers from 0930 to 1010 hrs, with several boats in the area, but there was no serious harassment. They were young dolphins, not fully adult, but not juveniles, one with a notch out of its tail, they finally headed out to sea.
- 7/4/07 A pod of about 15 Dolphins was seen close inshore off Black Head SW779162 near Coverack over the Easter Weekend, and a much larger

- pod of maybe 100 or more was seen further offshore. These were probably Common Dolphins.
- 7/4/07 2 known young Bottlenose Dolphins, one with a notch out of its dorsal fin, were seen off the mouth of Fowey Harbour SX120509 at 1530 hrs. This pair was seen off Penzance at 1000 hrs.
- 7/4/07 2 or 3 Harbour Porpoises were seen from Scillonian III at 1010 hrs when she was off Lands End SW341253. They porpoised across the bow heading south.
- 7/4/07 A Harbour Porpoise was seen from Scillonian III at 1130 hrs to the west of Wolf Rock Lighthouse.SW270120
- 7/4/07 2 Bottlenose Dolphins were breaching and playing off Penzance Harbour SW476303 at 1915 hrs
- 7/4/07 A 3 metre Basking Shark was seen off Gull Rock near Nare Head SW927368 at 1600 hrs.. This is the first Basking Shark seen off Cornwall this year
- 7/4/07 6 Common Dolphins were watched for 5 minutes off the Roseland Peninsula in position 50°08N 04°53W at about 0922hrs
- 7/4/07 A 3 metre Basking Shark was seen off Gull Rock, Nare Head SW927368 This is the first Basking Shark report for this year.
- 7/4/07 2 Bottlenose Dolphins were bow riding a boat for 10 minutes at 1500 hrs a mile south of Fowey SX120510
- 7/4/07 2 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen in Mounts Bay in position 50° 07N 05° 31.05 W at 1000 hrs Playing in one area and a Harbour Porpoise was seen heading west off Porthguarnon SW410230 at 1125 hrs
- 7/4/07 2 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen playing in an area of Mounts Bay in position 50°07N 05°31.05W at 1205 hrs and a Harbour Porpoise was seen feeding off carn Scathe SW374216 at 1415hrs.
- 8/4/07 2 Harbour Porpoises were seen feeding in Mounts Bay in position 50°6.4N 05°30W at 1200 hrs. and 2 more were feeding off carn Scathe SW374216 at 1425 hrs
- 8/4/07 A pod of about 12 Bottlenose Dolphins were in Torbay SX9260 at 0900 hrs heading across the bay from Torquay to Berry Head SX948567, where 3 Harbour Porpoises were seen at 0845 hrs
- 8/4/07 2 Harbour Porpoises were seen about 300 metres south of Lizard Point SW694115
- 9/4/07 A pod of at least 8 Bottlenose Dolphins was seen heading west 100 metres offshore in Bigbury Bay SX6642 at 1630 hrs
- 9/4/07 A female Grey Seal was seen close inshore in Lantic Bay SX1450 heading west.
- 9/4/07 2 Bottlenose Dolphins were being very playful in Mounts Bay in position 50°07N 05°29.05W at 1015 hrs
- 10/4/07 2 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen heading slowly east South of Mousehole in position 50°04N 05°32W at 1324 hrs
- 10/4/07 35 Common Dolphins, including 4 juveniles, were bow riding a boat for 10 minutes south of Fowey in position 50°18.40N 04°36.85W. They then left the boat and headed south.
- 10/4/07 2 male Grey Seals were close inshore on the west side of Lantivet Bay SX1650, but 50 yards apart.
- 10/4/07 A pod of Bottlenose Dolphins was in Penzance Harbour SW476303 at 0830 hrs

- 10/4/07 A Grey Seal was seen at the surface, below the NCI Lookout at Cape Cornwall SW349318 at 1232 hrs.
- 11/4/07 A Basking Shark was feeding in Fal Bay in position 50°07.96N 05°01 21W at 1310 hrs
- 11/4/07 2 Basking Sharks, 18ft and 25 ft long were circling and feeding at the surface 1.8 miles south of Pencarrow Head. There were fish feeding at the surface and lots of Guillemots in the area.
- 11/4/07 A Harbour Porpoise Was seen off Carn Scathe SW374216 circling and feeding at 1529 hrs.
- 12/4/07 3 Common Dolphins, 2 adults and a juvenile, were seen heading south 1 mile northeast of The Gwineas Rocks SX031420
- 13/4/07 A large female Basking Shark with a tall floppy dorsal fin and a large white patch on her nose was seen ½ mile southeast of Fowey SX120510 at 1430 hrs. Lots of Gannets in the area
- 13/4/07 2 Bottlenose Dolphins seemed to be resting in Mounts Bay in position 50°05N 05°31.5W at 1022 hrs
- 14/4/07 2 Basking Sharks, 18ft and 25ft long, were circling and feeding in Lantic Bay SX1450
- 14/4/07 2 Grey Seals were seen at the surface, below the NCI Lookout at Cape Cornwall SW349318 at 1336 hrs
- 14/4/07 A Grey Seal surfaced and bottled briefly 100 meters off Tunnels Beach, Ilfracombe SS524479 at 1140 hrs
- 14/4/07 2 Bottlenose Dolphins were breaching while heading west in Mounts Bay in position 50°03N 05°34.5W at 1045 hrs
- 14/4/07 A 2 to 2½ Basking Shark was seen about 70 yds offshore in Lantic Bay SX1450 at 0830 hrs.
- 14/4/07 A 3 to 4 metre Basking Shark stayed close inshore for about an hour around 1400 hrs, in Lantic Bay SX1450
- 14/4/07 2 Bottlenose Dolphin were seen heading west off The Manacles SW8120 at 1531 hrs
- 14/4/07 A 5metre Basking Shark was seen in Mounts Bay in position 50°05N 05°31W at 1451 hrs
- 15/4/07 2 Bottlenose Dolphins were travelling north in Mounts Bay in position 50° 05.4N 05°31.5W at 0905 hrs. and seen later slowly heading southwest in position 50°07N 05°31.5W at 0941 hrs
- 15/4/07 A pod of 60 to 80 Common Dolphins, including several juveniles, was swimming around the boat Charlotte Louise in Tor Bay SX9260 about 5 miles east of Paignton
- 15/4/07 2 Grey Seals were seen at the surface below the NCI Lookout at Cape Cornwall SW349318 at 1610 hrs
- 17/4/07 A large Basking Shark was seen off the Creggin Rocks near Cadgwith SW7213 at 0900 hrs
- 18/4/07 A small Grey Seal was seen bottling briefly 50 metres off Capstone Point SS519418 at 1620 hrs
- 18/4/07 A 12 ft Basking Shark was feeding just off Coverack SW783182 for most of the afternoon and then swam straight out to sea when it departed
- 19/4/07 A 12 ft Basking Shark, probably the same one as seen yesterday, spent most of the afternoon feeding off Coverack SW783182 and swam straight to sea when it departed.

- 19/4/07 A 10 to 12 ft. Basking Shark was circling, apparently feeding, at the western entrance to Plymouth Sound, off Picklecombe Point SX455515 at 1430 hrs
- 19/4/07 A pod of about 30 Common Dolphins was seen jumping actively near The Wolf Rock Lighthouse SW270120 from the Isles of Scilly helicopter at 1700 hrs
- 19/4/07 A large Basking Shark was seen from the Isles of Scilly helicopter close inshore off Tater du SW440230 at 1705
- 19/4/07 A large Basking Shark was seen 800 metres south of Mousehole SW470263 at 2000 hrs
- 19/4/07 A Basking Shark was seen feeding at the surface off Lamorna SW451241 at 1850 hrs and another was seen at 1855 hrs
- 19/4/07 2 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen heading southeast in Mounts Bay in position 50°07N 05°31.5W at 1543 hrs
- 19/4/07 A 5 metre Basking Shark was seen in Mounts Bay in position 50°6.5N 05°36.6W at 1535 hrs
- 20/4/07 6 Bottlenose Dolphins were off Wherrytown SW470274 at 1910 hrs with some surface activity close inshore.
- 20/4/07 A Basking Shark was seen in Sennen Cove SW3526 during the evening.
- 20/4/07 A 7 metre Basking Shark was seen off The Greeb SW530290 at 1945 hrs. and 2 Bottlenose Dolphin were seen just off Penzance Harbour SW479302 at 2015 hrs
- 20/4/07 A Basking Shark was seen to breach off Porthgwarra SW371216 at 1430 hrs
- 20/4/07 2 Grey Seals, a male and a female, were close inshore in Lantivet Bay SX1650, and a Pilot Whale was spy hopping ½ mile south of Pencarrow Head SX151503
- 21/4/07 A small Harbour Porpoise was sighted 3 times off Capstone Point SS519418. It came within 50 metres of the point and was hanging around just below the surface.
- 21/4/07 A 10 metre Basking Shark was close inshore off Porthcurno SW387222 at 1415 hrs
- 21/4/07 A 24 ft Basking Shark arrived at the Manacles SW8120 from Black Head at about noon and fed there for a few hours with lots of mackerel at the surface for miles around.
- 21/4/07 At 0830 hrs there was a lot of dolphin activity just outside Penzance Harbour SW476306 until a dive boat left the harbour, when the Bottlenose dolphins headed east and the Commons headed south west. There were estimated to be about 15 to 20 in each pod.

- 14/9/07 A Basking Shark, a Minke Whale and 2 Grey Seals were seen off Gwennap Head SW367215 by Seawatch Southwest observers
- 14/9/07 An 80 cm Ocean Sunfish was seen 2 mile off the mouth of the Helford River in Fal Bay in position 50°05.04N 5°03.2W at 1111 hrs
- 15/9/07 2 Basking Sharks, a Bottlenose Dolphin interacting with scuba divers and a Harbour Porpoise were seen of Gwennap Head SW367215 by Seawatch Southwest observers
- 15/9/07 5 Harbour Porpoises were seen feeding and breaching occasionally with 5 gannets diving off Beacon Point SS532482. Watched for 20 minutes from Capstone Point.

- 15/9/07 Thousands of By-the-wind-sailors, *Velella velella*, were washed up dead at Port Nis, Isle of Lewis NB536636
- 15/9/07 An Ocean Sunfish was in waist deep water just off the beach at Marazion SW574308 at 1100 hrs. Swimming upright at the surface, with dorsal flapping out of water. It was large dinner plate size.

It was 48 hours before I was able to look at it under the microscope and the delicate creature was already falling apart, and the only things I could find were millions of red dots in a white jelly.

- 15/9/07 A pod of about 10 Bottlenose Dolphins and 2 Harbour Porpoises, were seen off Lizard Point SW694115 at 1200 hrs
- 15/9/07 A pod of about 15 Bottlenose Dolphins was feeding, hunting, leaping and circling, with gannets diving off Rumps Point SW931812 at 1500 hrs. They followed a boat that drove through the pod and then headed north.

- 17/10/07 A Harbour Porpoise was seen 300 metres northwest of Capstone Point SS519418 at 1806 hrs. Observers were alerted by two diving gannets and saw the Harbour Porpoise surface twice, but it was soon lost to view by rough seas and low light.
- 17/10/07 A massive Sea Hare *Aplysia fasciata* , was seen grazing on a night dive at Drawna Reef, Porthkerris at 6 to 8 metres depth. A beautiful pinkish purple fringing a brownish purple body about 30 cm long.

- 3/11/07 An Ocean Sunfish was seen in Sennen Bay SW3526 today.
- 3/11/07 A Grey Seal was watched following a cormorant near The King Harry Ferry SW841396
- 3/11/07 5 or 6 Risso's Dolphins, including one baby, were seen heading east, in a very tight group just west of the Runnelstone SW369200 at 1245 hrs. and 5 Harbour Porpoises were in the area around the Runnelstone.
- 4/11/07 3 Harbour Porpoises were seen off Capstone Point at 1328 hrs. Two were surfacing simultaneously 300 metres offshore and one was further east. The pair was last seen heading west.
- 4/11/07 15 Harbour Porpoises were seen off Baggy Point SS419406, 22 were seen off Morte Point SS441458 and 4 were seen off Saunton Down SS437380. There was no evidence of feeding, only quiet trips to the surface, making it easy to count.
- 4/11/07 A Grey Seal stayed near a snorkeller for ½ hour off Pencarrow Head in position 50°19.51N 04°35.13W before heading west
- 4/11/07 4 dolphins were seen heading west off Ladies Window SX078906 at 1615 hrs
- 4/11/07 A Grey Seal was seen off Tubby's Head St Agnes SW698505 at 1250 hrs
- 5/11/07 A Grey Seal surfaced off the Cape Cornwall NCI Lookout SW350318 just after 4 Jet Skis roared past at 1515 hrs
- 6/11/07 A Minke Whale carcass stranded on Porthbeor Beach SW882367 after it had been watch for a few days floating offshore. The nine metre long female had a large gash on her head, and it is thought that she may have been struck by a ships propeller.
- 7/11/07 5 unidentified dolphins were seen heading east off Porthmeor Beach SW516410 5 during the morning
- 8/11/07 At least 2 Harbour Porpoises were seen feeding 20 metres off Berry Head SX948567 at 0900 hrs. 7 Gannets and several Herring Gulls were in the area.
- 11/11/07 20 or more individual Pearl Chains, *Apolemia uvaria*, were seen and photographed off Pencarrow Head SX151503. They varied in length from 25cm to 2 metres.
- 15/11/07 A pod of about 20 Common Dolphins was watched feeding beneath diving gannets from 1030 to 1115 hrs, gradually heading north, about 2 Km northwest of Cape Cornwall SW349318
- 16/11/07 15 to 20 Common Dolphins were seen south of Plymouth in position 50°05N 04°10W in the morning from F.V. Richard Ann. About 5 Common Dolphins were seen in the same position in the afternoon
- 18/11/07 A Grey Seal was seen heading north close inshore off Penance Point SW805305 at 1300 hrs. It then dived and was not seen again.

- 18/11/07 A Harbour Porpoise was seen off Berry Head SX948567 at 0910 hrs and 4 Bottlenose Dolphins were off the head at 1135 hrs
- 19/11/07 A Harbour Porpoise was seen heading slowly west off Capstone Point SS519418 at 0744 hrs
- 20/11/07 About 20 Common Dolphins were seen from the Gwennap Head Lookout SW365217 at 0846 hrs, feeding beneath gannets near the Wolf Rock Lighthouse SW270210. They moved closer to the lookout by 1000 hrs, about 1.5 Km to the west, still feeding with about 300 gannets diving. There were quiet periods when the gannets rested on the surface and the dolphins disappeared below, presumably to drive the fish toward the surface resulting in a frenzy of diving gannets. They were still in the area at 1330hrs.
- 21/11/07 A very large thresher shark was caught 3½ mile south of The Runnelstone SW369200. When weighed it was found to be 510 Kg (1122 lbs) making it one of the heaviest thresher sharks caught anywhere in the world and the second giant from Cornish waters in a few weeks. The female was 15ft 10" long and sold at Newlyn Market for £255-00, (50p per kilo). It may not be eaten, but more likely stuffed for display purposes.
- 21/11/07 A Jellyfish invasion has wiped out Northern Ireland's only salmon farm, killing more than 100,000 fish, which could cost more than £1m Billions of small jellyfish, *Pelagia noctiluca*, known as Mauve Stingers flooded into the cages off Glenarm Bay. The jellyfish covered an area of up to 10 square miles and a depth of 35 feet
- 21/11/07 20 or more Bottlenose Dolphins were seen off Hope's Nose Torbay, SX950637
- 22/11/07 2 Harbour Porpoises were seen just off the tip of Rospletha Head SW384217 at 1115 hrs.
- 23/11/07 2 Harbour Porpoises, an adult with a juvenile, were 100 metres south of Porthgarra Cove SW371216 at 0930 hrs.
- 23/11/07 3 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen heading into Torbay off Berry Head SX948567 at 1610 hrs
- 23/11/07 A Grey Seal was seen below the Cape Cornwall NCI Lookout SW350318 at 1401 hrs
- 25/11/07 The British record for a shore caught Bass, which stood at 19lb, was recently broken by a catch off Sandown Pier, Isle of Wight with a weight of 19lb 11oz 12dr
- 25/11/07 5 dolphins were seen heading west off Downterry SX315538 and on to near Looe Island, followed by gulls.
- 25/11/07 6 or more Bottlenose Dolphin were seen from Tregantle SX387526 close inshore heading west breaching and twisting as they went past Portwrinkle and on toward Looe, from 1345 to 1410 hrs
- 28/11/07 A Grey Seal was seen bottling for ½ minute at 1441 hrs, close to rocks 400 metres west of Capstone Point SS519418. It had a large head, so probably a male.
- 28/11/07 3 or 4 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen heading west off Porthmeor Beach SW516410 at 1100 hrs
- 28/11/07 6 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen heading west off Gwithian Towans SW579411 at 1145 hrs.

- 29/11/07 A Minke Whale and a Risso's Dolphin were seen about 1.5 to 2 Km south of the Gwennap Head Lookout during the day. Also seen was a low blow of an unidentified whale about 6 km SW of the lookout.
- 2/12/07 3 or more Harbour Porpoises were seen off Slinke Dean SW461245
- 3/12/07 A whale was seen to spout a few hundred metres off Carn du SW457235 at 1400 hrs. It was watched for about 20 minutes, by several people as it blew again and breached several times. It was black on the back and very white on the underside.
- 6/12/07 A carcass of a 3.2 metre Bottlenose Dolphin was recovered from Gunwallow Fishing Cove SW654223. and sent for post mortem by the Cornwall Wildlife Trust Marine Strandings Network. It appeared to be in poor condition and, with no marks on the body, was not thought to be bycatch. The results of the post mortem test are pending and it is hoped that it will shed light on the cause of death. A whale lice was found on a healed wound on the dolphins flank which is thought to be *Isocyamus dolphinii*.
- 10/12/07 2 adult Harbour Porpoises were seen feeding close inshore off Charlestown SX0451 after a storm.
- 12/12/07 14 Grey Seals were seen hauled out in a cove at the south end of Towan Beach SW869324. Seals have been regularly seen hauled out at this cove over the past 5 years.
- 12/12/07 3 large and 1 small Triggerfish were found on the strandline at Watergate Bay SW842655
- 12/12/07 3 Bottlenose Dolphins heading east at first then turned back west off the NCI Lookout at St Ives SW521411 at 0830 hrs
- 16/12/07 A cuttlebone of *Sepia orbignyana* was found on the strandline at Mexico Towans SW559389. Other cuttlebones on the strandline were probably *Sepia officinalis*.
- 17/12/07 A pregnant Bottlenose Dolphin was found at Gunwalloe Fishing Cove SW654223. It was retrieved for post mortem by Cornwall Wildlife Trust Marine Strandings Network. The dolphin was 3.2 metres long and appeared to be in poor condition. Whale lice, thought to be *Isocyamus dolphinii*, were found on a healed wound on its flank. Post mortem results are pending and it is hoped that these will shed light on the cause of death. It is not thought to be bycatch.
- 21/12/07 6 Harbour Porpoises, including a juvenile, were seen with gannets 2Km northwest of Cape Cornwall SW349318 at 1200 hrs
- 23/12/07 A Grey Seal was seen 100 metres off Ilfracombe Pier SS527479 at 1330 hrs. It surfaced three times and bottled for a while then headed west. At 1345 hrs a Harbour Porpoise was seen milling and resting 100 metres off Capstone Point SS519418. On both occasions small gulls were overhead, probably Blackheaded Gulls.
- 23/12/07 A Harbour Porpoise was seen off Berry Head SX048567 at 0845 hrs
- 23/12/07 A Harbour Porpoise was seen 700 metres off Porthgwarra Cove SW371216 beneath feeding seabirds, Kittiwakes and Auks.
- 24/12/07 At least 6 Harbour Porpoises including one young one, were seen off Berry Head SX948567 at 1030 hrs. They spent some time feeding and playing.
- 24/12/07 A dead Triggerfish was found on the tide line at Trevone SW890761

- 25/12/07 4 Harbour Porpoises were seen off Berry Head SX948567 at 0830 hrs. They were difficult to see in the rainy conditions.
- 25/12/07 A pod of 10 to 12 Common Dolphins followed a boat for about 30 minutes off Pendennis Castle SW824317. Many photos taken.
- 26/12/07 At least 6 Harbour Porpoises were off Berry Head SX948567 from 0900 to 0930 They were feeding in 3 groups far apart then headed south and were lost in the sun.
- 26/12/07 3 Harbour Porpoises were seen off The Rumps SW933811
- 27/12/07 8 Harbour Porpoises were watched for 1 hr 25 mins off Berry Head SX948567, then they headed south.
- 27/12/07 A pod of at least 7 Bottlenose Dolphins was seen from St. Ives Island SW521411 heading east south east. Also in the Bay there were at least 4 Harbour Porpoises, with shags, cormorants, gannets and auks in the area.
- 28/12/07 5 Harbour Porpoises were off Berry Head SX948567 from 0835 to 0945 hrs
- 29/12/07 6 Harbour Porpoises were feeding in the tide race off Berry Head SX948567 from 0845 to 0930 hrs.
- 29/12/07 A late Basking Shark was seen in St. Loy Cove SW424230
- 29/12/07 A dead Triggerfish with partly chewed fins was found on Sennen Beach SW351263 at 1530 hrs.
- 30/12/07 A Harbour Porpoise was seen circling 500 metres north of the lighthouse at Bull Point SS461469 from 1400 to 1500 hrs
- 31/12/07 6 dead Triggerfish have been found on Porthcothan Beach SW8572 and 2 on Mother Iveys Bay SW8676 in the last 4 days and today one was washed ashore still alive at Constantine Bay SW8574 as well as several that are very small.
- 31/12/07 6 to 8 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen heading east off Porthmeor Beach St Ives. SW516410 at 0920hrs
- 31/12/07 4 Harbour Porpoises were seen near The Brisons SW340311 at 1210 hrs.
